Schools etc., on the pattern of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sanghathan with **no claim for absorption.** The minimum qualifications as per the recruitment rules should be adhered to maintain the quality of education.

Further vide ref.5th cited, the NESTS have communicated the clear guidelines for engaging the Guest teachers for EMR Schools through the District Level Committee headed by the District Collector concerned.

In view of the circumstances and based on the delegation of powers to the District Level Committee stipulated in the EMRS operational guidelines, it is decided to entrust the hiring the qualified and experienced teaches in the cadres of **PGT / TGT / PET / Art teacher / Music teacher** as guest teachers in Ekalavya Model Residential Schools to the District Level Committee (DLC) headed by the District Collectors concerned. The following are the officials proposed by the NESTS in the DLC for taking up the recruitment / engaging the Guest faculty for EMR School.

- 6. Prepare detailed guidelines, terms and conditions of selection of Guest teachers and upload in the Web application / display in the Office of the District Collector concerned / Project Officer, ITDA, Dy. Director (TW) / DSTWOs of Non-ITDA districts and EMR Schools.
- 7. Ensure that, the entire process shall be completed by the end of 10th August, 2022 without fail.
- 10.There is no roster system in selection of teachers as they are engaged as guest faculty.
- 11.In view of Co.Education system under residential pattern in EMR Schools, maintain the equal ratio of male and female teachers in each EMR School.

Andhra Pradesh immediately.

Further, the NESTS, MoTA, New Delhi have issued clear guidelines that, the above said posts shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion by the State Society.

The Salaries / Honorarium etc., shall be paid to the staff engaged in Ekalavya Model Residential Schools through PFMS only as per the guidelines communicated by the NESTS.

Further, the NESTS have not sanctioned the Class-IV posts i.e., from Office Subordinate to MPW posts for Ekalavya Model Residential Schools. Alternative steps shall be taken up by the Secretary, Gurukulam in consultation with the Commissioner, NESTS, New Delhi.

All the Principals of Ekalavya Model Residential Schools should follow the above staffing pattern during the academic year 2022-23 and based on the workload and only after attaining the higher classes year by year, the Secretary, Gurukulam shall accord permission for filling up the additional teaching and nonteaching posts.

Based on the guidelines and instructions received from time to time from the NESTS, MoTA, New Delhi., directions shall be issued by the Secretary, Gurukulam for filling up the teaching and non-teaching staff posts either from State level (or) through District Level Committee headed by the District Collector concerned only.

The above orders shall come into force with immediate effect.
